Hitchin Service Update

Our Hitchin site is the most recent addition to the safe and secure accommodation we provide across the three counties we currently operate in.

With 21 individual, private rooms all with ensuite facilities and 24 hour service, security and support, Hitchin PAIRS provides accommodation to those who are working towards stable, independent living accommodation for up to 12 to 18 months.

It has been a pleasure for our teams to attend some great partnership events this month, alongside our ongoing committed partnership work to delivering responses to Homelessness together.

[The Homeless Link - Prevention into Action](#) conference was a great event provided by Homeless Link - Laurence our Community Locality Manager - Beds and Herts - said the conference gave such alignment to how we work, discussing how agencies work in a person centred approach together to prevent homeless, understand and influence what may be perceived as risk and complex needs through a trauma informed model. Through understanding how we can disrupt and prevent evictions in the first instance we can prevent further trauma and harm to those in disadvantaged situations.

Homelessness Pathway Event - hosted by NHFT- Jess our Operations Manager found the event to be hugely productive and a great next step - bringing together all partner agencies to talk together about mental health and homelessness and to collaborate towards and action plan for improving access to services for those who need it most.




Recent events
